Subj: UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS AT EXAMINATION SESSIONS

Ref: (a) Auxiliary Manual, COMDTINST 16790.1E

1. **PURPOSE.** To provide policy and guidance for uniform standards for Qualification Examiners while on Boat Crew/Coxswain Qualification in the Eleventh Coast Guard District Auxiliary, Southern Region.
2. **DIRECTIVES AFFECTED.** This Policy Directive supersedes all other Eleventh Coast Guard District, Auxiliary Southern Region Policy Directives, which contain provisions concerning uniform standards of Qualification Examiners.
3. **DISCUSSION.** The Qualification Examiner is a direct representative of the Coast Guard while performing QE duties. It is imperative that the QE adheres to certain Uniform Standards.
4. **ACTION.** Qualification Examiners assigned to an examination session will wear Undress Blue Uniforms with member Insignia, Nametag, and Proper Breast Insignia/Devices (No Ribbons or Officer Insignia). The Coast Guard hot weather uniform will be allowed as per COMDT's Policy. The Light blue polo shirt is also authorized; however, no member pins or devices will be worn. Effective immediately, all Qualification Examiners shall adhere to this directive.
