**JAN 2006 District Conference Legal Memorandum—Addendum .01**

At the District Conference Operations Workshop on 8 JAN 2006, the OTO distributed DIRAUX Directive 06-01 (dated as of 1 DEC 2005) regarding "Manning Levels" for Patrol Boats. This new Directive 06-01 cancels and supersedes the DIRAUX Directive referred to in Paragraph E.4 (at page 4) of the JAN 2006 Legal Memorandum.

Under this new Directive 06-01:

1. DIRAUX no longer will impose a maximum limit on the number of BoatCrew (CXN and qualified Crew members) on a Patrol boat. Rather, the maximum number of BoatCrew will be at the CXN's discretion, exercised in accordance with consideration of all pertinent factors (particularly including the Patrol Boat size).
2. Minimum BoatCrew must be in compliance with the Operations Policy Manual requirements, **plus** in D11(SR) there must be one additional qualified Crew member on all Patrols Boats less than 26 feet long (except the plus one policy is waived for Patrol Boats operating on inland lakes and rivers).
